Veteran Service Officer will provide the following services:

- Initiate a service-connected compensation claim with the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs
- Guide veterans through the process of gathering medical documentation to support service connected compensation claims
- Initiate a request for lost military separation papers
- Initiate and develop appeals when appropriate
- Death and burial benefits
- Memorial Day placement of flags on the graves of war veterans
- Dependency Indemnity Compensation Assistance

The CVSO also provides referral services, including:

- Individual counseling
- Group counseling
- Family counseling
- Marital counseling
- Alcohol and drug assessment
- Employment counseling
- Agent Orange information and referral
- Post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD) referral
- Traumatic brain injury (TBI) counseling
- Readjustment counseling for combat veterans and their families
- Bereavement for families who lose an active duty service member
- Education and Vocational Rehabilitation/Employment
- GI Life Insurance and waiver of premiums
- Medical information for in-patient, outpatient and nursing home care
- Home loan guaranty assistance
- Pension claims with the Department of Veterans Affairs

In order to complete a compensation claim, an appointment will need to be made so that adequate time and consideration can be given to each Veteran for his/her individual circumstances.
